

The 2017 April BOS Regular Meeting Synopsis

The April Regular BOS meeting was called to order by Chairman Harris and determined there was a quorum. Supervisor Whitaker offered the invocation and everyone joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. The agenda was approved on a motion by Supervisor Jones. The March Regular and Continued minutes, along with all financial reports were approved.

No one spoke during the Public Comments.

David Whitaker, Planning and Zoning Director gave the monthly VDOT report of projects in the County.

Ray York and Patty Averett of Environmental Management, awarded Brian McClung of Waste Management and David Traub and Rick Nevell of McDonalds for their ten years of support and participation of the Annual Amelia spring Green/Clean up.

County Administrator, Taylor Harvie gave a report on the latest Courthouse Renovation plans.

A Public Hearing was held for the FY2018 Budget. Heather Barton asked the Board to consider more funding for the Amelia Sheriff's Office. No one else spoke.

Mr. Harvie reported on the results of the latest Zoning Appeals Board case.

Mr. Harvie also told the Board that Dominion Virginia Power has requested an easement on Anderson Lane to run underground lines. Mr. Harvie thought this would be a good time for the County to abandon the property.

In the County Administrator's Report, Mr. Harvie reported that the Waste Management host fee check for March was \$236, 278.90 and reminded the Board that Duke Energy has delivered the last of the coal ash.

Piedmont Regional Jail Board minutes were presented from the March 22, 2017 meeting along with a County Health Rankings and Roadmaps study.

Piedmont Regional Juvenile Detention Center submitted the March 22, 2017 Commission meeting minutes and Department of Social Services submitted their February 2017 Financial Statement.

Cumberland County sent an invitation to attend the 14th Annual Patriot Day Celebration on April 22, 2017.

The Commonwealth Transportation Board will conduct public meetings on projects and programs for the FY2018-2023 Six Year Improvement Plan.

Virginia Resources Authority submitted the 2016 Annual Report and a letter from the Amelia Sheriff's Office was given to the Board answering questions that were asked at the Budget Workshop.

During the Board members comments, Supervisor Jones thanked the businesses that sponsored the PSR event "A Racy Affair".

Supervisor Barnard said he has resident complaints regarding skateboarding in the streets.

The April BOS meeting was continued to April 27, 2017 at 11:00 am on a motion by Supervisor Jones.
