The Electoral Board of Amelia County met on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 in the Registrar's Office. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams.

Minutes of the March 12, 2019 meeting were reviewed and approved as presented.

Officers of Election (OOE) for the June 11<sup>th</sup> Democratic Primary were selected and assigned to a voting precinct. A low voter turnout is expected, so only four workers were assigned per precinct, and 1800 (300 x 6) ballots were ordered for this election.

Smith met with county representatives regarding early voting in 2020, which would allow voters to vote one week before the week of the election. This will have a dramatic impact on the voting process in every locality in Virginia.


We discussed having some type of OOE recognition at the General Election training session, tentatively planned for October 29<sup>th</sup>.
