

## **DEPUTY ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER**

The County of Amelia is accepting applications for a full-time salaried position as Deputy Animal Control Officer. The successful applicant shall be responsible for the enforcement of local ordinance and state law regulating the keeping of animals and animal control, within the County. Essential duties shall include, but are not limited to, responding to animal control calls, patrolling to observe animal violations, picking up loose, injured or sick animals, and investigating animal bites. Also, maintains public relations with citizens regarding general animal control, licensing, and disposition of unwanted or dangerous animals. Successful applicant shall be in the possession of chemical capture and euthanasia certificates or the ability to qualify for them within six months of hire. Applicant shall qualify for the handling of firearms under guidelines issued by the Commonwealth of Virginia within six months of hire. The successful applicant must have and maintain a valid Virginia driver's license and must have the ability to work weekends and holidays. Position salary is in wage band 5 (\$30,000 to \$45,000) and shall be based on qualifications.
