

Official Voting Information  
Democratic and Republican Primaries  
June 12, 2018

The Democratic and Republican Parties of Virginia have called for party primaries for the November General Election this year. The Republican Primary will be for the US Senate, and the Democratic Primary will be for the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District of the House of Representatives. Both primaries will take place together on Tuesday, June 12, 2018. This makes the election a dual primary. In order to participate, you will need to present your photo id at your assigned polling station in which you are registered to vote AND request either a Republican or Democratic ballot. By law, you may request either party's ballot but you must request one in order to vote. You may only vote in one of the primaries, not both. One primary; one ballot; one vote; your choice.

We are currently absentee voting for the primary. You may request an absentee ballot for either party online, by mail, or in person. The Virginia State Department of Elections has further information. The Amelia County Website also has a link to the ballot application under Government and Voter Registration. The last day to register to vote for the primary is Monday, May 21, 2018. The last day to vote absentee is Saturday June 9, 2018.

Of course, you are always welcome to contact your Voter Registration Office which is located in the Boepple Building at 9127 Washington Street, Suite 102. Make your plans to vote. We are at your service.
