The Electoral Board of Amelia County met on Monday, February 4, 2019 at 10:00 A.M. in the Registrar's Office. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the 2020 budget, OOE training, VEBA annual meeting and update on legislative issues.

Minutes of the January 9, 2019 meeting were reviewed and approved.


The County's proposed FY2020 budget includes \$47,000 for capital improvements to the Registrar's office. Those improvements would include a dropped ceiling, updating the furnace, HVAC maintenance, lights and flooring. Smith will discuss with the County the possibility of redesigning the office space for greater efficiency.

Based on current information, it is likely that we will have a June primary this year. Training for Officers of Election will be discussed at the March meeting. Focus on training will be targeted for the Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs and new Officers of Elections.
