

**AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE AND AMEND THE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND RATES IN THE AMELIA COURTHOUSE SANITARY DISTRICT**

Be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Amelia County Virginia, acting in its capacity as the board of the Amelia Courthouse Sanitary District, that the schedule of fees and rates charged to water and sewer service customers within such district, adopted May 24, 2007, and last amended August 21, 2013, is further amended and reordained, following a duly advertised public hearing on as follows:

1. Service Application Fee

The basic service application fee shall be \$150.00. When the County determines that any water and sewer drawing(s) submitted to the County require review and comment by outside professionals, the County shall charge a fee for the review in the amount of direct cost of the review plus 10% for administrative handling by County staff.

2. Copy Charges

Ordinances	\$10.00 per copy
Construction Specifications and Standards	\$15.00 per copy

\* No charge for Construction Specifications and Standards w/ service application

3. Facility Fees

A. Water Facility Fee

i. Class I – Residential Customers and Class II –all others

- ii. Fire sprinkler systems shall be 50% of the facility fee
- iii. Residential meters are restricted to 2 inches or less

B. Sewer Facility Fee

Class I – Residential Customers and Class II – all others

\* Residential meters are restricted to 2 inches or less

Note: This amendment was effective from the date of its adoption until August 31, 2016, at which time such rates were further extended by action of the Board of Supervisors on July 20, 2016. Their action extended the decrease until August 31, 2019.

4. Water and Sewer Monthly Charges

A. Capacity Charge

Commercial//industrial meters of 3 inches or greater may be negotiated.

B. Usage Charges

Use shall be billed as follows:

i. Class I – Residential Customers and Class II – all others

Per Month per gallon	Water	Sewer
	0.0045	0.005

ii. Sewer fees for facilities not connected to public water shall be assessed based on a water use rate of 5,000 gallons. In lieu of this rate, the owner may install, at their own expense, a meter approved by the Sanitary District to record the actual gallons pumped from a private source and discharged through their sewer connection. This meter shall be placed on the exterior of their facility on the inlet side of their connection and be accessible to County employees for the purpose of recording the monthly flow.

5. Connection Fees shall be cost plus 10% to cover labor and equipment when County performs the service.

6. Discharge Permit Fee

7. Hauled Wastewater

From domestic sources (private septic tanks, porta-johns, etc)

\$0.10 per gallon of measured flow

From all other sources (industrial, other wastewater treatment facilities, etc.)

Negotiated based on the material discharged (composition, chemical and physical characteristics, volume, and so forth.)

8. Heavy Waste Fees

BOD <sub>5</sub>	Total Bill X 0.5	X	<u>BOD<sub>5</sub>mg/l</u> 250mg/l
TSS	Total Bill X 0.1	X	<u>TSSmg/l</u> 250mg/l
TKN	Total Bill X 0.5	X	<u>TKNmg/l</u> 25mg/l
Oil and Grease	Total Bill X 0.5	X	<u>Oil and Grease</u> 100mg/l

\* Substances not listed above may be negotiated based on materials discharged.

9. Penalties.

A 10% penalty charge shall be assessed on delinquent accounts as described in the Water and Sewer User Ordinance. Further penalty fees described in the Water and Sewer User Ordinance may also be assessed.


10. Other fees.

The Board of Supervisors may adopt other fees and charges as it may deem necessary to carry out the requirements contained in the Water and Sewer User Ordinance.

11. Effective date.


This ordinance and the revised fees and rates herein shall be effective and applicable to all bills rendered on or after July 1, 2017.
