The Electoral Board of Amelia County met on Thursday, January 25, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. in the Registrar's Office. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams. The purpose of the meeting was to review the three applications received for the General Registrar position.

Minutes of the January 9th meeting will be reviewed for approval at the February 6th meeting.

Ads were placed in the Farmville Herald, Amelia Bulletin Monitor and on the county's website. Three (3) individuals submitted an application for the position. The deadline for applications is Tuesday, January 30th. Based on the qualifications for the position, two candidates were deemed not qualified and one candidate was selected for an interview. The interview is scheduled for Wednesday, January 31st at 2:00 PM. If additional applications are received, they will be reviewed on Wednesday, January 31st. If necessary, additional interviews will be conducted on Tuesday, February 6th.

At the request of the Registrar, we agreed to purchase an additional voting machine to ensure a machine is available for emergencies and training. Money ~~should be~~ ^{is} available in the budget to cover the cost.

Chairman Williams will check to see if sufficient funds are in the budget to cover the cost of the Board to attend the State Electoral Board meeting at the Homestead.

On January 11th, Chairman Williams attended a legislative event reviewing election bills and meeting with Senator Amanda Chase and Delegate Tommy Wright. Governor Ralph Northam spoke at the event.
