The Electoral Board of Amelia County met on Tuesday, January 8, 2019 at 10:00 A.M. in the Registrar's Office. The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Barley. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss attending the VEBA conference and topics of interest that may be addressed in this year's General Assembly session.

Minutes of the November 7th and 9th, 2018 meetings were reviewed and approved.

Smith will be attending the VEBA conference at the Homestead. Review of the budget reflects sufficient dollars to cover his estimated \$725.00 cost. Chair Williams plans to attend, Barley was unsure at the time and Johnson will not be attending.

The FY2020 budget reflects \$47,000 for improvements to the Registrar's office. Smith will check to see exactly what renovations are being planned.


Training for Officers of Election will be held in May or June depending on whether we have to hold a June Primary election.

Smith reviewed the possible topics that will be discussed during this year's General Assembly session. Topics include campaign reform, Photo ID legislation, Vote by Mail bill, Election Day a holiday, legislation to outlaw discrimination regarding time off for EB members and Assistant Registrars, also, House Bill 1615 to change primary election date from the 2nd Tuesday to the 3rd Tuesday. (*Schools will be out*) and four bills addressing No Excuse Absentee voting.

The next meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at 10:00 AM.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 AM.
