The Amelia County Sheriff's Office is pleased to announce that it will award two scholarships of \$500.00 each to one graduate of Amelia County High School and one graduate of Amelia Academy.

Mandatory Requirements:

- 1. Candidate must be a graduating senior in the year of the award who will be attending an Institution of Higher Learning in the next academic year.
(trade school, college, university, community college)*
- 2. Candidate should have a clear financial need.*
- 3. Candidate should have the highest moral character and integrity.*
- 4. Candidate should have a positive reputation in behavior and attitude.*
- 5. A letter of personal reference from someone in the community (who is not related to you).*
- 6. A letter of academic reference from teacher, principal or assistant principal.*
- 7. An official High School Transcript.*

Please contact the Guidance Office for the application deadline.

All applications will be reviewed and a final decision made by a committee from the Amelia County Sheriff's Office and the family of Johnny F Black. The committee will be assisted by teachers, guidance counselors and other school staff.

Scholarship announcement will be made at Senior Class Night.

Funds will be directly sent to the institute to be credited in the recipient's account upon written notification of the admission of the student.

If for any reason the recipient is unable to fulfill the above requirements, the committee will award the scholarship to the next qualified applicant on its list.
