Chairman Harris called the March 27, 2017 Continued Meeting of the Amelia County Board of Supervisors to order at 1:00 P.M. for a Budget Workshop and determined there was a quorum with five members in attendance.

Finance Director, Carla Cave presented several ideas to the Board to increase revenue. One was to revise billing for water and sewer. There was discussion of a meals tax and a continued discussion regarding the percentage for business license fees.

The Amelia County School Board presented their budget and told the Board they would not be requesting any additional funding for FY2018. Jack McKinley thanked the Board for contributing more local funds than the State requires.

Allen Vernon addressed the repaving of the parking lots at the schools.

The Amelia County Sheriff's Office addressed the Board and requested additional funding for salaries and replacing work stations. Sheriff Walker stated he was losing dispatchers to higher paying jobs after investing in their training. He also said work stations are crowded and falling apart.

The Treasurer's Office submitted a request via letter to make 2 part time positions into one full time position and to increase salaries for 3 fulltime employees.

On a motion by Supervisor Jones, the Board unanimously agreed to accept the budget with no changes to the Treasurer's Office and to defer action on the Sheriff's Office request.

There being no other business, the March 27, 2017 Continued Meeting was adjourned on a motion by Supervisor Jones.
