

VIRGINIA: AT A CONTINUED MEETING OF THE COUNTY OF AMELIA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 27, 2018.

Chairman Harris called the March 27, 2018 Continued Meeting of the Amelia County Board of Supervisors to order at 2:00 P.M. for a Budget Workshop.

Kenneth Llewellyn spoke on behalf of the Amelia Fire Department and explained they are trying to avoid using CIP funds as in the past for truck purchases. They have created a 5 year plan to rotate replacement of trucks. They have requested a \$100,000 increase in their \$400,000 budget.

The Amelia County Sheriff's Office addressed the Board and requested additional funding for supplies and vehicle equipment, maintenance and service, travel and supplies. He reduced several line items. The Sheriff's Office has requested an increase of \$58,200 to their \$2,380,885 budget.

The Circuit Court Clerk's Office sent a letter requesting \$10,000 additional funding to their \$292,621 budget for a part time employee.

The Heart of Virginia Free Clinic sent a request for funding of \$1000.00.

Jill Hames of the JL Hamner did not request an increase but explained that the County must fund at or greater than the previous year in order to receive State funding.

On a motion by Supervisor Whitaker, the Board agreed to advertise for a Public Hearing during the regular board meeting April 18, 2018 for a .2 cent tax increase over the equalized .47 cents.
