The Electoral Board of Amelia County met on Wednesday, November 7, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. in the Registrar's Office. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams. The purpose of the meeting was to canvass the results of the November 6<sup>th</sup> election.

Statement of Results information was reviewed. The provisional ballots were reviewed and one held for ID verification.

This meeting ended at 12:15 pm and will be continued on Friday, November 9<sup>th</sup> to determine status of the provisional ballots.

The meeting reconvened at 12:00 Noon on Friday, November 9<sup>th</sup>.  
The ID provisional ballot was not counted as the voter failed to provide ID. The provisional ballots voted were eight (8). 63.6% of registered voters voted in this election.

We discussed the news story that highlighted some voting issues and recognized that the media did not accurately report the story.

Discussed plans to proactively provide pertinent information to voters prior to the election and explain how to address any voting concerns. For process improvement, we need to simplify the recordkeeping process, including the CAP process.

Need to budget for the purchase of a new laptop (poll book); Peter to check with Carla. We will continue to evaluate the role of the Chiefs and provide training as deemed necessary.

Peter will review the pay for "Bo" and Laura.

Minutes of the September 25<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved as presented.  
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, January 8, 2019.
